

PAUL'S PRAYERS / *1 Thessalonians 3:10*

Reference

Paul prayed . . .

Romans 10:1	. . . that the Jews might be saved by believing in Jesus Christ.
2 Corinthians 13:7, 9	. . . that the believers would not do anything wrong, but would pass the test and be made perfect in Christ.
Ephesians 1:17	. . . that the believers would be given the Spirit of wisdom and revelation so that they would know God better.
Ephesians 3:16-19	. . . that the believers would be filled with the Holy Spirit and experience God's love in its fullness.
Philippians 1:4, 9	. . . that the believers' love for one another would abound more and more in knowledge, depth, and insight.
Colossians 1:9	. . . that the believers would have a knowledge of God's will and be made wise with spiritual wisdom.
1 Thessalonians 3:10	. . . that he and his coworkers could return to the believers and teach them further.
2 Thessalonians 1:11	. . . that God would make the believers worthy of the life to which he called them, and that God would fulfill all their good intentions and faithful deeds.
Philemon 1:6	. . . that Philemon would be active in sharing his faith.

Paul requested . . .

Romans 15:30-31	. . . that they join in his struggle for the churches, that he would be rescued from the Jews who persecuted him, and that the Christians would accept the financial gift he was delivering from all the churches.
Ephesians 6:19-20	. . . that God would give him the right words to share the Good News and that he would be able to keep on speaking boldly, despite his chains.
Colossians 4:3	. . . that God would give him and his coworkers many opportunities to preach the Good News.
1 Thessalonians 5:25	. . . that believers pray for him: "Brothers and sisters, pray for us."
2 Thessalonians 3:1	. . . that God's message would spread rapidly and be honored.
2 Thessalonians 3:2	. . . that God would save them from wicked and evil people.
