

CRUCIAL CONCEPTS IN ROMANS / *Romans 3:25*

Election <i>Romans 9:10-13</i>	God's choice of an individual or group for a specific purpose or destiny.
Justification <i>Romans 4:25; 5:18</i>	God's act of declaring us "not guilty" for our sins, making us "right" with him.
Propitiation <i>Romans 3:25</i>	The removal of God's punishment for sin through the perfect sacrifice of Jesus Christ.
Redemption <i>Romans 3:24; 8:23</i>	Jesus Christ has paid the price so we can go free. The price of sin is death; Jesus paid the price.
Sanctification <i>Romans 5:2; 15:16</i>	Becoming more and more like Jesus Christ through the work of the Holy Spirit.
Glorification <i>Romans 8:18-19, 30</i>	The ultimate state of the believer after death when he or she becomes like Christ (1 John 3:2).
